Yearly Provider License	<p>Allows practice to include/exclude providers that wish to participate in the Quality Payment Program. Electronic Prescribing	<p>The ability to send an electronic prescription to the pharmacy. Impacted certification criteria may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 170.318(a)(1) -- CPOE - Medication</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(4) – Drug-drug, drug-allergy interactions</li> <li>• (x) 170.315(a)(7) – Medication List</li> <li>• (x) 170.315(a)(8) – Medication Allergy list</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(10) – Drug Formulary Checks</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(13) – Patient Specific Education</li> <li>• 170.315(b)(3) – Electronic Prescribing</li> <li>• 170.315(g)(2) /170.315(g)(2) – Automated Measure Calculation</li> </ul>	<p>There is a monthly fee from Systemedx per provider to be able to send electronic prescriptions to pharmacies.</p> <p>An additional monthly charge from Systemedx may also be applied if a provider wishes to send controlled substances electronically to pharmacies. Additional, yearly subscription and hardware fees from Exostar (or similar third party) may also apply to utilize sending controlled substances.</p>
Patient Portal Access	<p>Secure Patient portal that enables patients to see records and communicate with practice staff. Impacted certification criteria may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 170.318(a)(1) -- CPOE - Medication</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(7) – Medication List</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(8) – Medication Allergy List</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(5) – Record Demographics</li> <li>• (x) 170.315(a)(6) – Problem List</li> <li>• (x) 170.315(a)(11) – Smoking Status</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(12) – Family Health History</li> </ul>	Utilization of the Patient Portal will incur additional monthly fees per provider.

Lab Interfaces	<p>Sending Lab and Diagnostic orders electronically and subsequently receiving Lab and Diagnostic Results Electronically.</p> <p>Impacted certification criteria may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 170.315(a)(2) – CPOE Laboratory</li> <li>• 170.315(a)(3) – CPOE Imaging</li> </ul>	<p>Practices utilizing interfaces to transmit lab/diagnostic orders and/or results may be subject to fees to establish connection with the third party facility. Some facilities may pay this on behalf of the practice depending on facility policies, practices, and contractual agreements.</p> <p>Practices will be subject to monthly support fee’s to support interface connections.</p>
Direct Messaging	<p>The ability to send Direct Messages among other Physicians.</p> <p>Impacted certification criteria may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 170.315(h)(1) - Direct Project</li> <li>• 170.315(h)(2) - Direct Project, Edge Protocol, and XDR/XDM</li> </ul>	<p>In order to send direct email messages to other providers, providers are subject to a small monthly fee.</p>
Immunization Registry Submission	<p>Ability to transmit Immunization information with immunization registries.</p> <p>Impacted certification criteria may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 170.315(f)(1) - Transmit to Immunization Registries</li> <li>• 170.315(f)(2) - Transmit to Public Health Agencies - Syndromic Surveillance</li> </ul>	<p>There is a small fee per provider per month in order to submit immunizations to related registries.</p> <p>This fee also may also apply to the Syndromic Surveillance Registries should a practice elect to utilize this functionality</p>
API Access	<p>170.315(g)(10) – Standardized API for Patient and Population Services</p>	<p>Consideration may be made for third parties to have API access licensed with an associated fee.</p> <p>Cost for API for Developers is \$10,000 yearly fee per application accessing the API. There is no additional cost outside of normal subscription/maintenance fees to providers/clinics for access to the API.</p> <p>(Changes to fees will be reflected in this document)</p>
